- Nursing: Current Concepts and Practices Video Collection
- LibChat
- Practical Law (Trial)
- JSTOR & ARTSTOR collections are merging

Nursing: Current Concepts and Practices Video Collection

- Began as a trial for the Nursing program in April 2021. Activated as part of the library collection at the end of May 2021, ahead of the Summer sessions.
- About the resource: *Infobase *Content has publication date 2015 or after
- Accessible through the [library's database page](#) (or bookmark the [link](#))
- Content is updated regularly (added and removed). If something is removed but still needed, we have the option to purchase it.
- Adds to the library's streaming media options ([Swank](#), [Academic Video Online](#) through Alexander Street Press, [kanopy](#))

LibChat

- Activated in March 2020, directly after the onset of remote operations. Took the place of in-person reference services, & it supplemented services via email.
- Embedded into the [library home page](#) and elsewhere (on the LibGuides)
- Staffed by the librarians (Martin, Dan, Olivia & occasionally Pam, and part-time librarians) during normal library hours
- Screensharing feature added during Summer of 2021.
- Heavily used by certain sections of ENG102 required to meet with a librarian
- Time for a demonstration?

Practical Law (Trial)

- This is a new product from the company that publishes most of the resources for legal education.
- The unique feature of this database is its content focuses on legal and ethical issues across a wide range of disciplines.
- Additionally, its content is written in lay language for those not familiar with legal terminology and it references the actual legal cases that led to the laws that are cited

JSTOR AND ARTSTOR MERGE

- In 2021 JSTOR launched a project to bring Artstor to JSTOR, to create a robust platform for discovering and working with both text and images.
- Throughout 2021 and into 2022, images from Artstor collections are being added to JSTOR
- Due to its cost, the library had to discontinue our subscription to Artstor in 2019.
- Now Artstor has merged with JSTOR to provide access to over 95% of its images.
- Effective now, you can access openly accessible Artstor images on JSTOR.

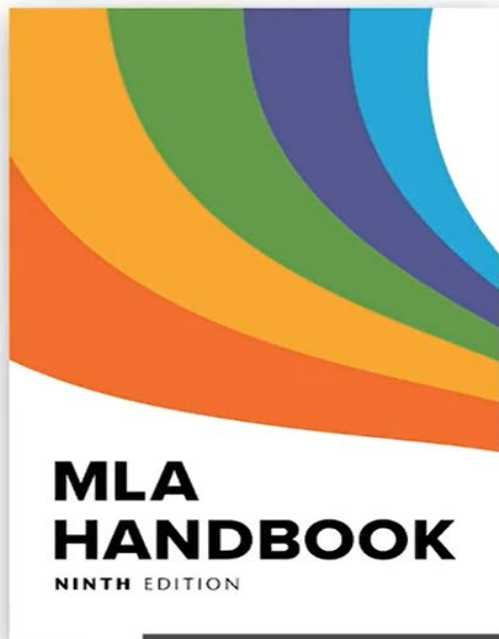
ImageQuest (from Encyclopedia Britannica)

- Activated during remote operations, Fall 2020 – no other digital image collections at the time. (We had canceled other products as not useful.)
- Rights-cleared for educational, non-commercial use. Student presentations & papers.
- Accessible on the library's [database page](#), or bookmark [the link](#).
- Interface seemed easy to use and helpful, so we did renew it for FY22.

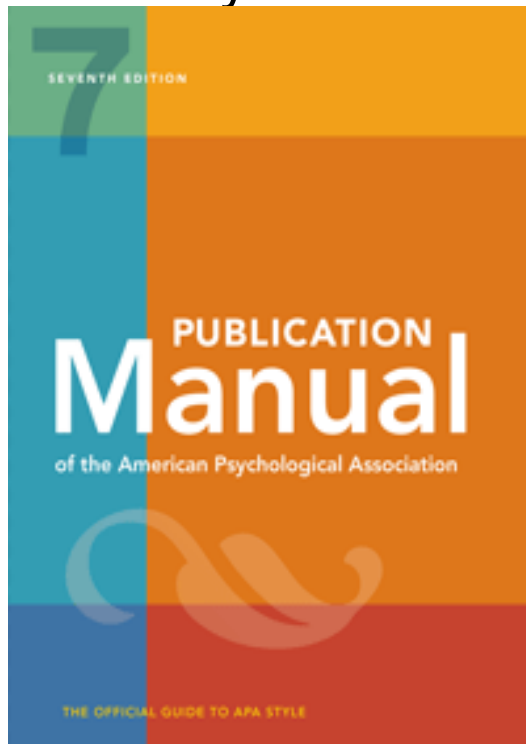
