Uniform Requirements

Nursing students are required to purchase their nursing uniform from our uniform vendor, Belle Uniforms. Belle Uniforms will be on campus on June 1st from 11am-3pm and June 6th from 3p-6pm. Payment is made directly to Belle Uniforms, in form of cash, check, or major credit/debit card. Purchased uniforms are shipped directly to the student.

The student nurse clinical uniform includes:

- Forest green top with MCCC Nursing Student emblem patch
- Forest green scrub bottoms
- White lab coat with MCCC Nursing Student emblem patch
- Name pin
- MCCC photo ID badge
- White uniform shoes or predominantly white sneakers (no open back or sling back shoes)

Plain white undershirts (including long sleeve) may be worn under scrub top. No logos may be visible on undershirt. Proper supportive undergarments are to be worn, including socks. Undergarments should match student skin tone or uniform so as not to be visible. Socks or support hose may be colored but no graphics may be visible.

Accessories to the uniform may be obtained from multiple sources, including Belle Uniforms and the Mercer County Community College bookstore. Accessories to the uniform are:

- stethoscope
- blood pressure cuff
- trauma or bandage scissors
- penlight
- watch with second hand
