- Your Financial Aid Award will not be posted until the APSI is submitted to the Financial Aid Office.
- If you do not meet the requirements of the plan, your SAP appeal and your financial aid will be cancelled. The Financial Aid office will monitor your courses/grades/completion each semester while you are under the terms of the plan.
- Your **ACADEMIC PLAN FOR SAP IMPROVEMENT (APSI)** may be for more than one semester. You must adhere to it each and every semester. Any deviation will make this plan void.
- Be sure to meet with your advisor if you do not feel that you can meet the terms of the plan.

Credits earned for Developmental Studies courses are not college level credit (see catalog), therefore they do not count in the GPA calculation for Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
