What is a Study Group Leader?

Each volunteer Study Group Leader will lead a 2-hour study group each week in one of the learning centers during the fall 2019 semester. Study Group Leaders will be trained by staff in the Tutoring Services department during a 1-hour training session the second/third week of the semester. Successful Study Group Leaders will also have the opportunity to serve again during the spring 2020 semester. Specific study groups will vary but likely include algebra, statistics, anatomy & physiology, chemistry, and accounting, as well as a wide array of other courses.

In recognition of service, **certificates** and **honor cords** for commencement will be bestowed upon successful completion of the semester.

What are the Requirements?

- 1) 3.0 GPA minimum
- 2) Enrolled in at least 3 credits for the fall 2019 semester at Mercer County Community College
- 3) Name of an MCCC faculty or staff member who would recommend you
- 4) Either
 - a. Successful completion (B or better) of the potential study group course OR
 - b. Enrollment in the potential study group course with demonstrated success (B or better) in a previous related course or courses (ex. enrollment in BIO 104 with an A in BIO 103).
- 5) Availability of 2 hours per week from week three/four through finals week of the fall 2019 semester
- 6) Interview
