## THIS IS NOT THE OFFICIAL PETITION FORM

* The purpose of this document is to help the prospective MLT Professional Student understand how we rank and award seats to applicants each year.

O Students applying during the open Petition period (February) for the MLT Professional Phase Program will need fill in a grid where they list the earned-grade and the year each prerequisite course was taken. There are course expirations and minimum grade requirements.

* POINT SCORE WORKSHEET (Page 2)

O SECTION 1 is used to see if you meet the minimum GPA requirement of 2.5 or better and this is where you are awarded points for your performance in prerequisite courses. You can plug your grades in the "Letter Grade" column and calculate your "Grade Points". Add your grade points up and divide by the total number of credits to calculate your GPA. Then, add up your total number of points for that section.
O SECTION 2 awards points to students who matriculated at Mercer County Community College the earliest. This date is created after you apply to MCCC and when you first begin taking courses towards earning the A.A.S. Degree.
O Our goal is to assist students in obtaining a degree in the shortest timeframe possible. Thus, extra points are awarded to students who began their studies earlier.
