Financial Aid Process



- Submit FAFSA
- Check MyMercer portal for updates and to submit any required documents
- Check NJFAMS portal for updates and to submit any required documents
- Register for classes
- Review award letter and accept/decline offered aid
- Check MyMercer portal to ensure aid has been applied properly

Create your FSA ID

Create a New FSA ID

An FSA ID is a username and password that gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member.

You are not allowed to have an employee or agent of a commercial entity, or other third party, create an FSA ID for you for any purposes including but not limited to: payment reductions, debt consolidation or applying for aid. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

Important: When you are done, select the CANCEL button to clear your data even if you did not finish creating your FSA ID. Just closing your browser window or going to another website may not be enough to prevent other people using this computer from seeing your information until the session expires.

NJ Financial Aid Deadlines



- 2022-23 School Year
 - NEW STUDENTS:
 - FAFSA due 9/15/22 for state aid (fall and spring)
 - FAFSA due 2/15/23 for state aid (spring only)
 - No state aid for summer semester
- 2023-24 School Year
 - FAFSA due 4/15/23 for state aid for renewing students
 - NEW STUDENTS:
 - FAFSA due 9/15/23 for state aid (fall and spring)
 - FAFSA due 2/15/24 for state aid (spring only)

NJ State Financial Aid Process



- Submit the FAFSA
 - Remember the state has earlier deadlines
- Always read emails from HESAA or NJFAMS
 - State gives 30 days from initial notification to complete any assigned tasks
- Log onto NJFAMS portal to check status or upload documents

NJ Community College Opportunity Grant (CCOG)



To Qualify, You Must...

- Have a total household adjusted gross income not exceeding \$65,000.
- Not have a prior college degree.
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>, including submission of all required documents.
- Make satisfactory academic progress.
- Program has been expanded, but details still coming

Satisfactory Academic Progress



- To remain eligible for financial aid, students must make Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- SAP is calculated every semester
- If you fail SAP, you can appeal with a Success Coach
- Withdrawing from classes can affect your financial aid award AND SAP




To be considered for all federal, state, and MCCC financial aid, students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

- Financial Aid Staff is here to help!




