



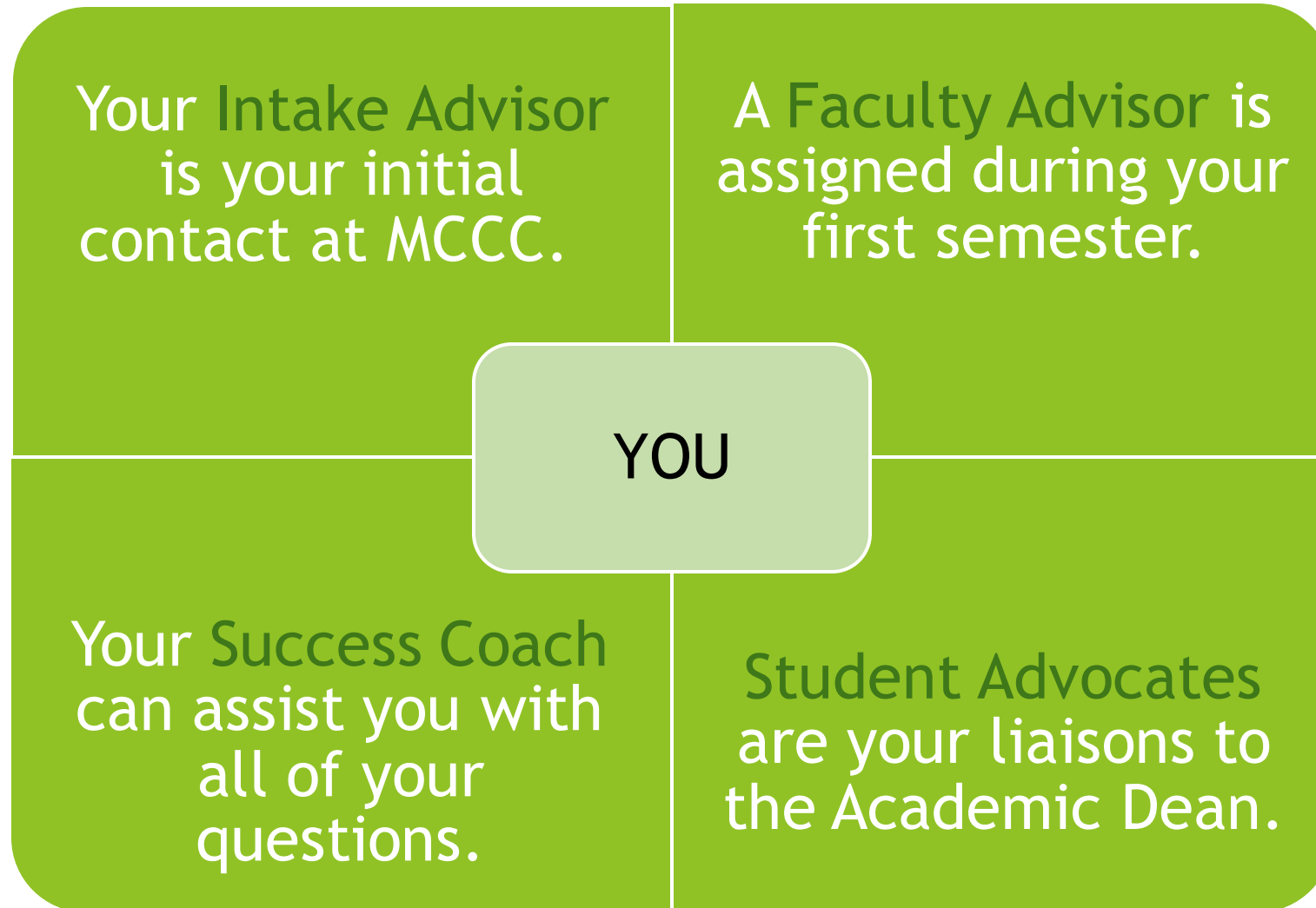

Whether it is through volunteering time, attending events or providing financial gifts, there are so many ways to connect with the current students, fellow alumni and with the College.

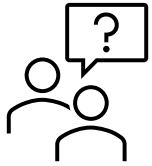

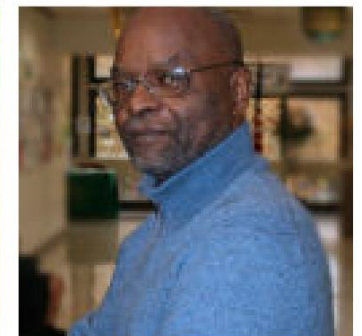
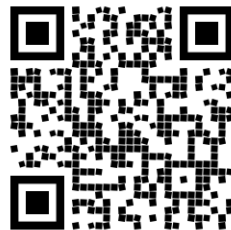

Important MCCC Policies

FERPA - Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

We cannot discuss student info with your parents, we can only discuss with you.

Refunds on Tuition

For a 14 week semester: 7 days from start of semester

Less than 14 weeks: 2 days from start of semester

Attendance

Communicate absences to professor

Excessive absences could affect financial aid and grades

GPA

Can affect program eligibility, scholarships, transfers

Aim high! Get help early with tutoring, support from professors.

Academic Integrity

Turn in your own work! There are severe consequences if you present someone else's work as your own.

Title IX

Sexual harassment, violence, or discrimination NOT tolerated. Serious consequences on your record if you violate Title IX law

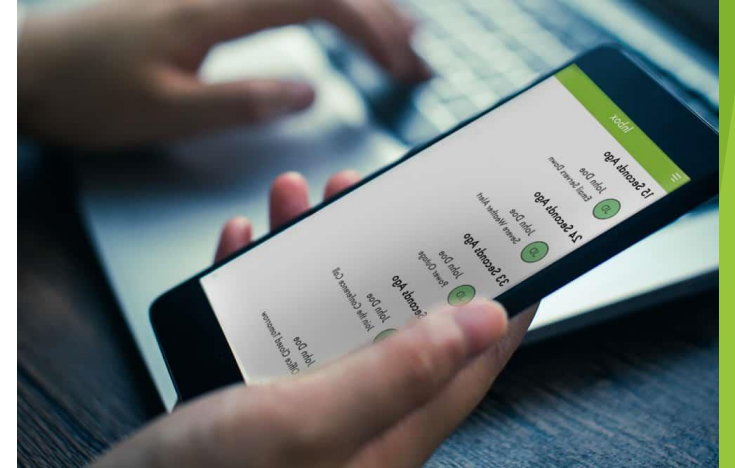
