The MCCC Horticulture Program Wins Again!


MCCC takes home three additional awards for historic record-breaking haul

Mercer County Community College (MCCC) continued its winning streak in a historic way this year shattering previous records at the Philadelphia Flower Show -- the oldest and largest flower show in the world -- taking home the gold medal in the "Education" category for its "Majestic" display at the Pennsylvania Convention Center.

"This is our third gold medal since 2017," said Professor Amy Ricco, coordinator of the college's Horticulture, Science and Sustainability program.

MCCC horticulture students also took home two additional medals and an honorable mention -- breaking the college's previous record.

"We received a total of four awards this year," said Ricco, "the most ever."





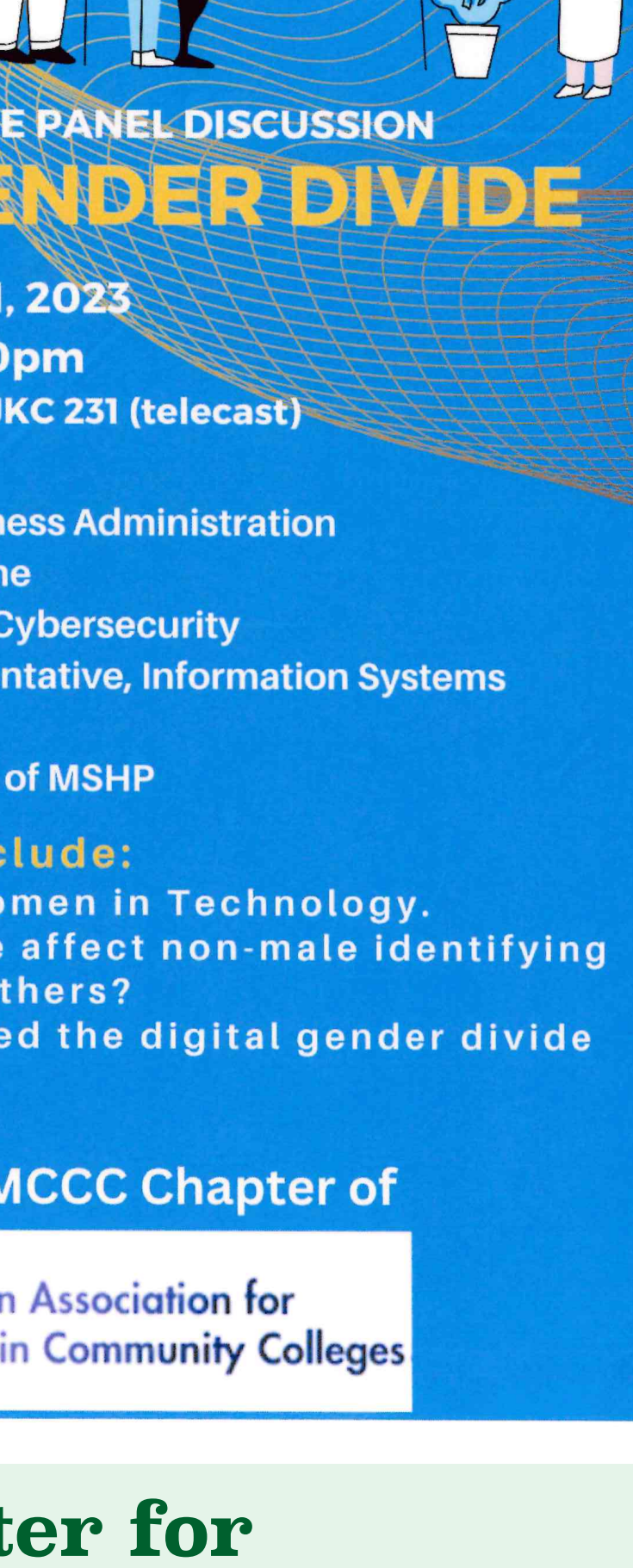


Athletics Spotlight

Women's Soccer Player Schroeder Selected as NGWS Award Winner

Mercer sophomore women's soccer player Lisa Schroeder (Leiferde, Germany/Sportsymnasium Neubrandenburg) has been selected as the Vikings National Girls and Women in Sports (NGWS) Woman of the Year Award Winner. Schroeder's achievements on the field and in the classroom led to her selection. Schroeder was honored at Seton Hall University on Saturday, February 18 th.

Schroeder earned 1st Team All-Region 19 honors this fall and was also named the Region 19 Women's Soccer Player of the Year. The sophomore back helped lead the Vikings to the first undefeated (14-0) regular season in MCCC women's soccer history. Read the [full story](#).

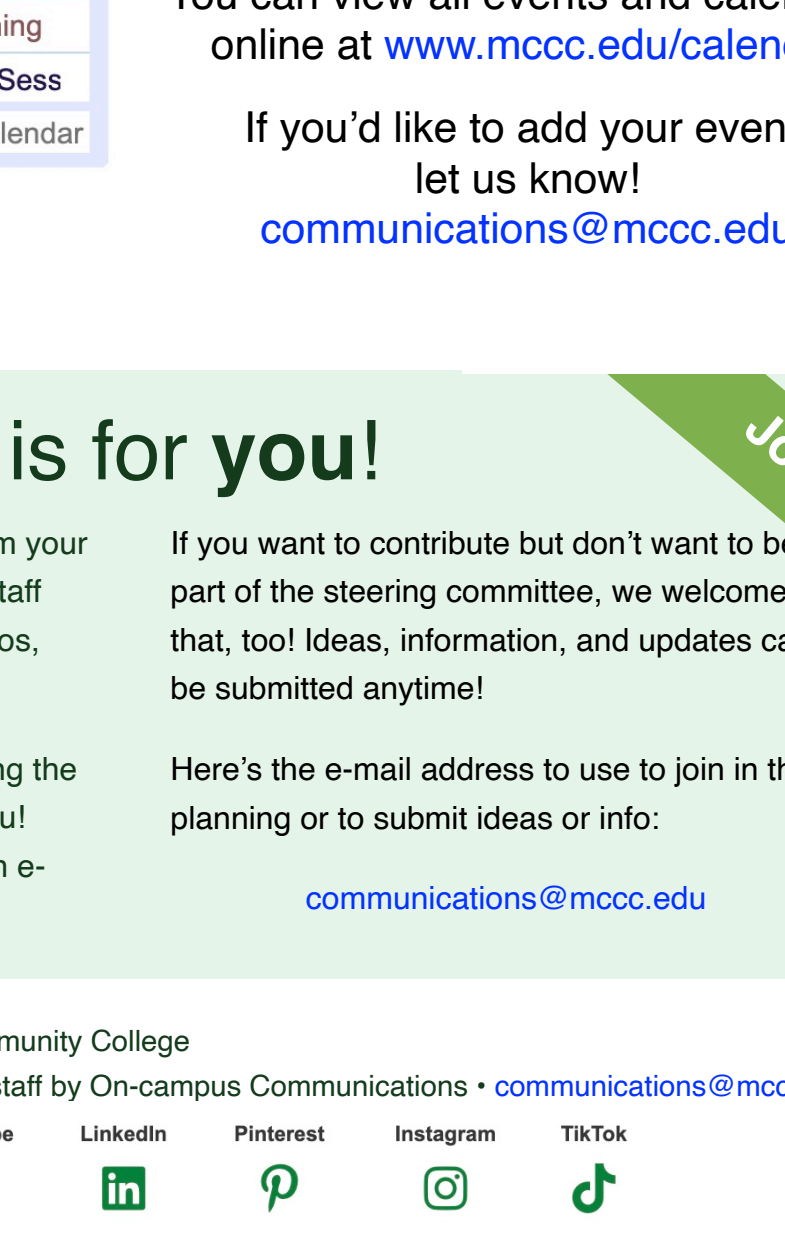

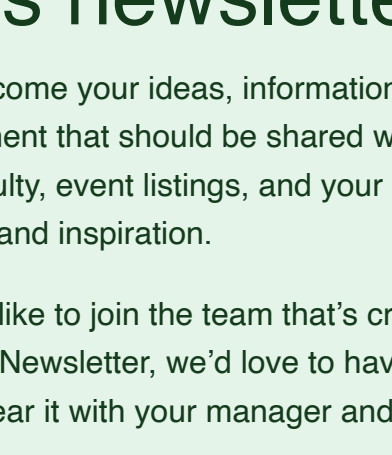
