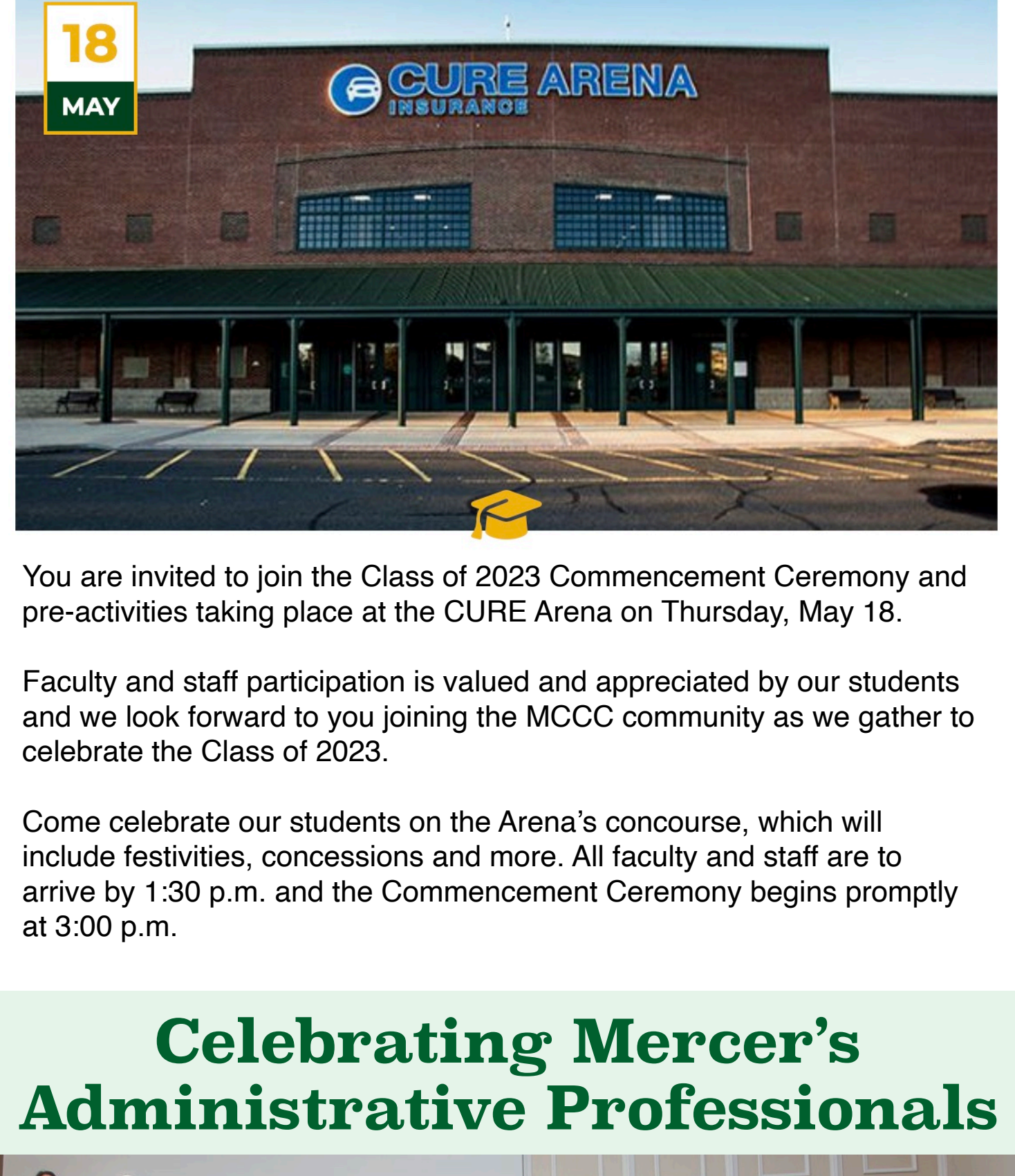

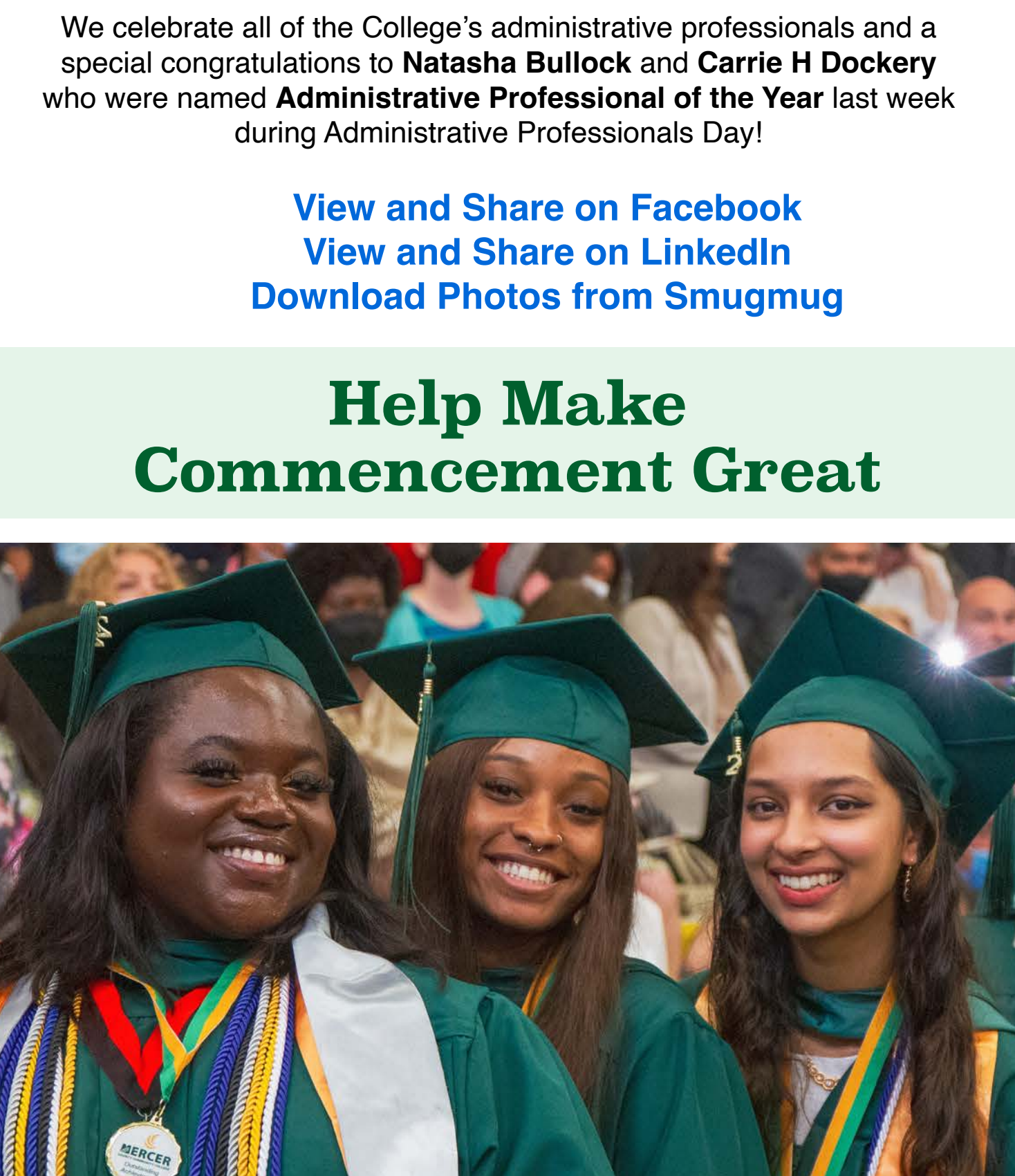

May 18: Commencement at the CURE Arena

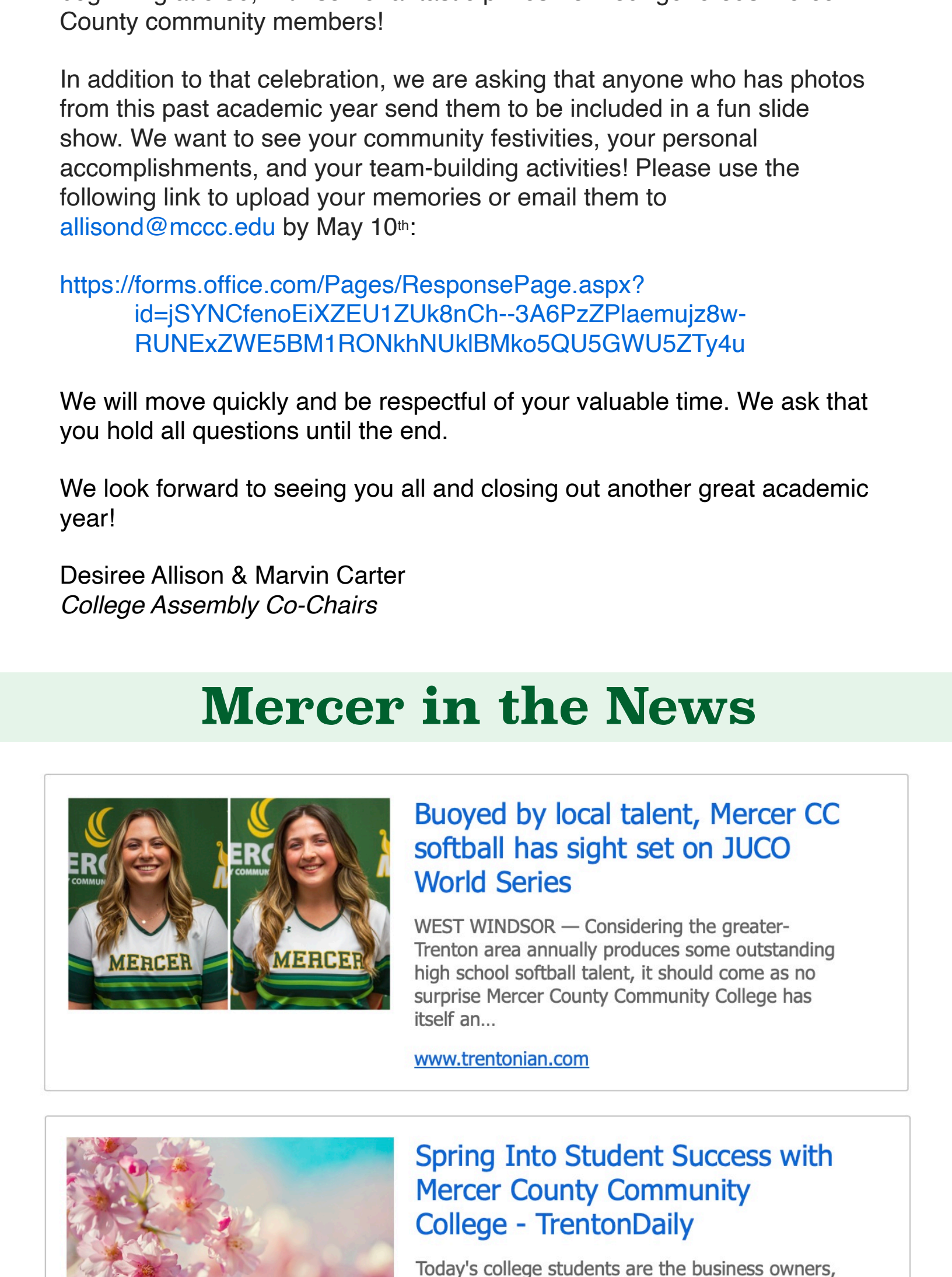


You are invited to join the Class of 2023 Commencement Ceremony and pre-activities taking place at the CURE Arena on Thursday, May 18.

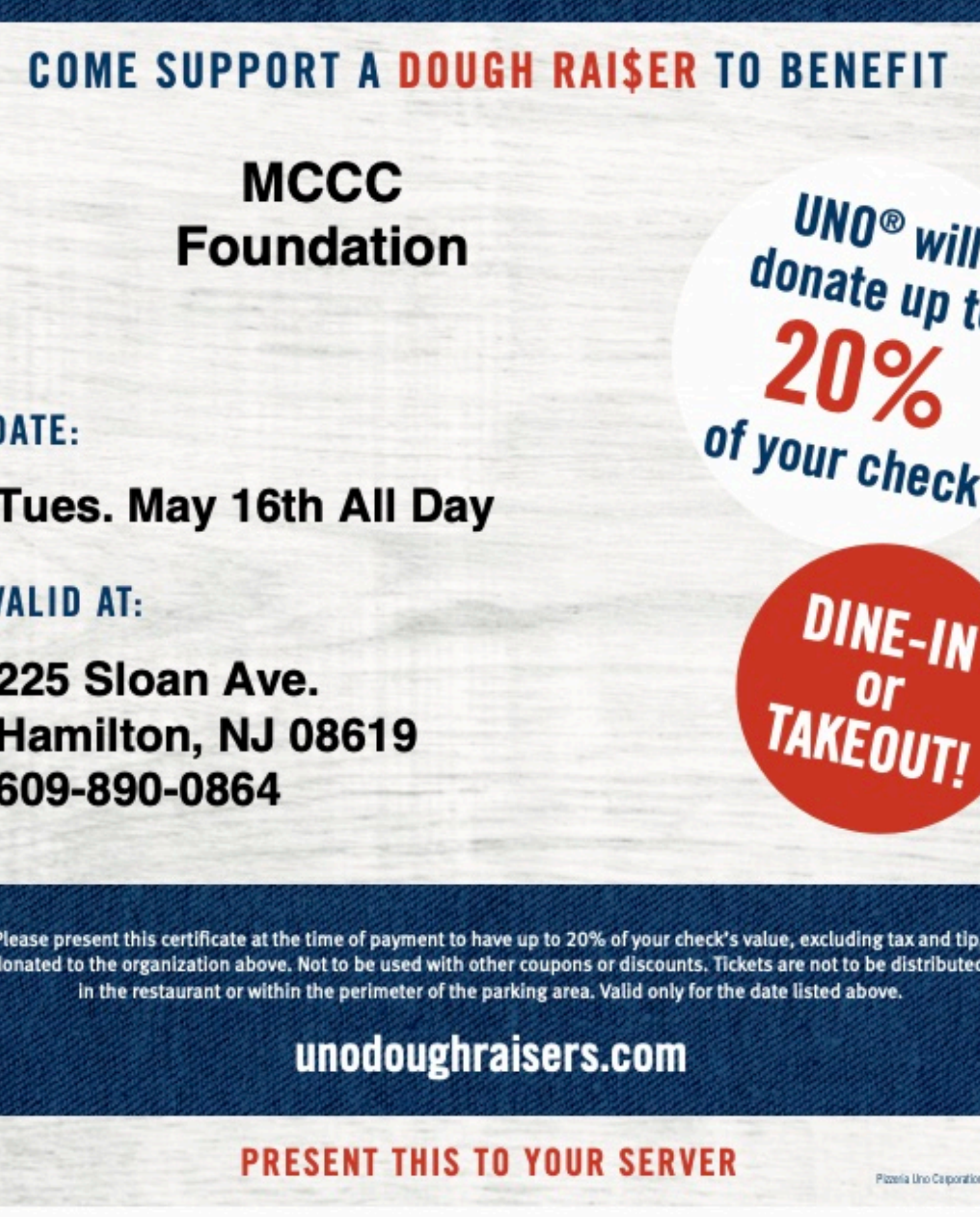
