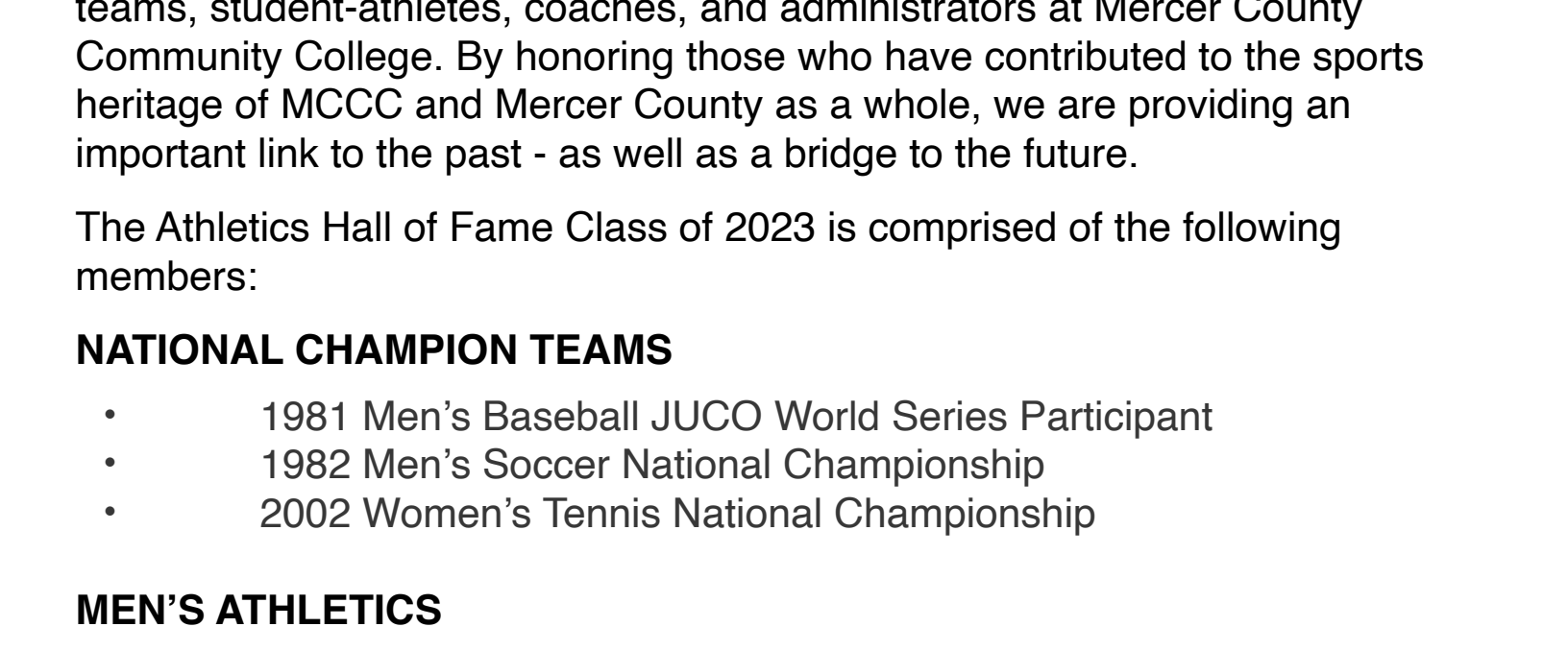

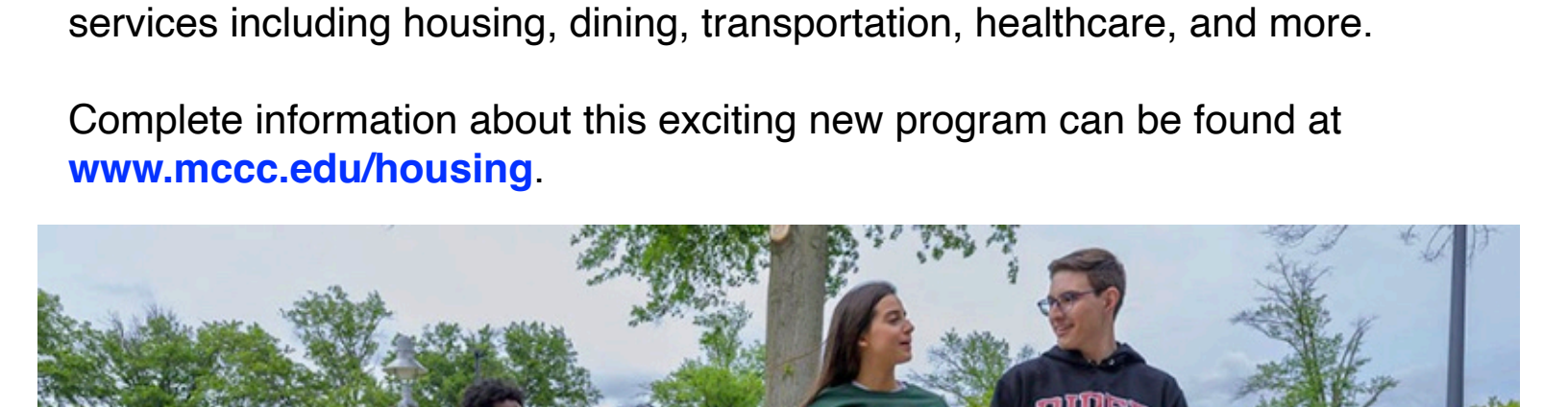

Update on MCCC ALERTUS Emergency Alert System



In ongoing efforts toward safeguarding our campuses, College Safety has worked with Information Technology Services to upgrade MCCC's **ALERTUS** Emergency Alert System to improve the college community's emergency communications.

Each college-issued desktop and laptop device will be equipped to allow users not only to send requests for emergency assistance but also to receive any emergency alerts issued from **ALERTUS**.

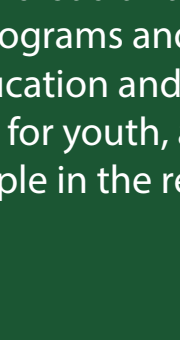
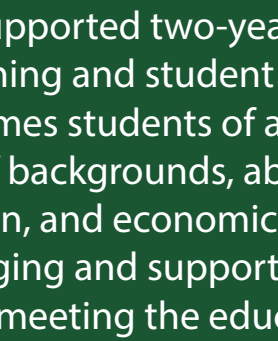
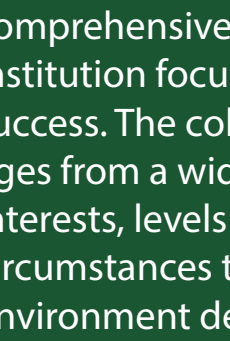
The **ALERTUS** system sends and receives such alerts for on-campus only and for emergency situations only, not for regular assistance from College Safety. Note also that the **ALERTUS** system is not replacing our current M-Alert system, which provides one-way communication for the college's emergency/urgent notifications.

Mission Statement

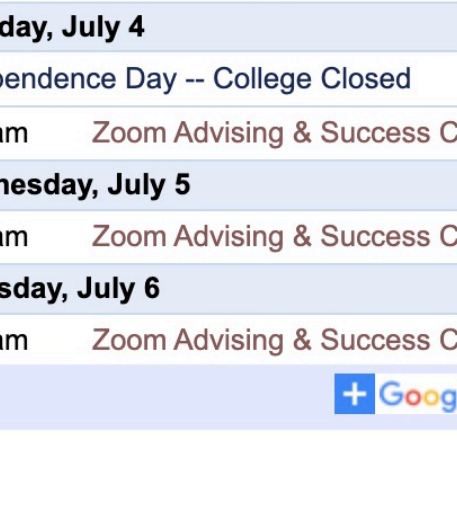
