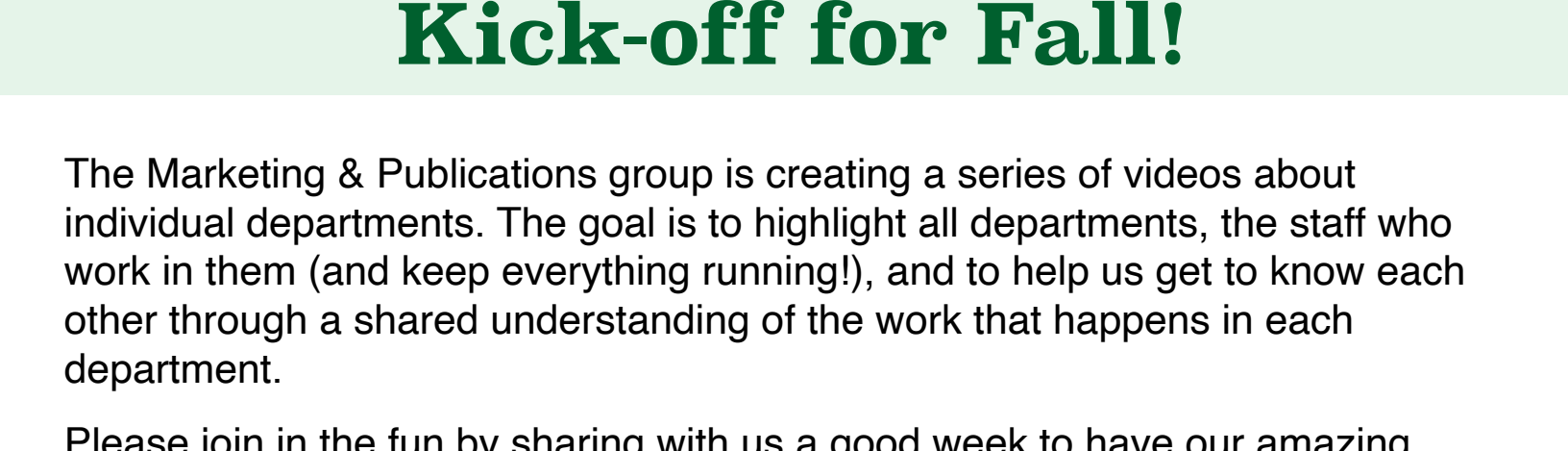

## Senior Leadership Gears Up During Planning Retreat!



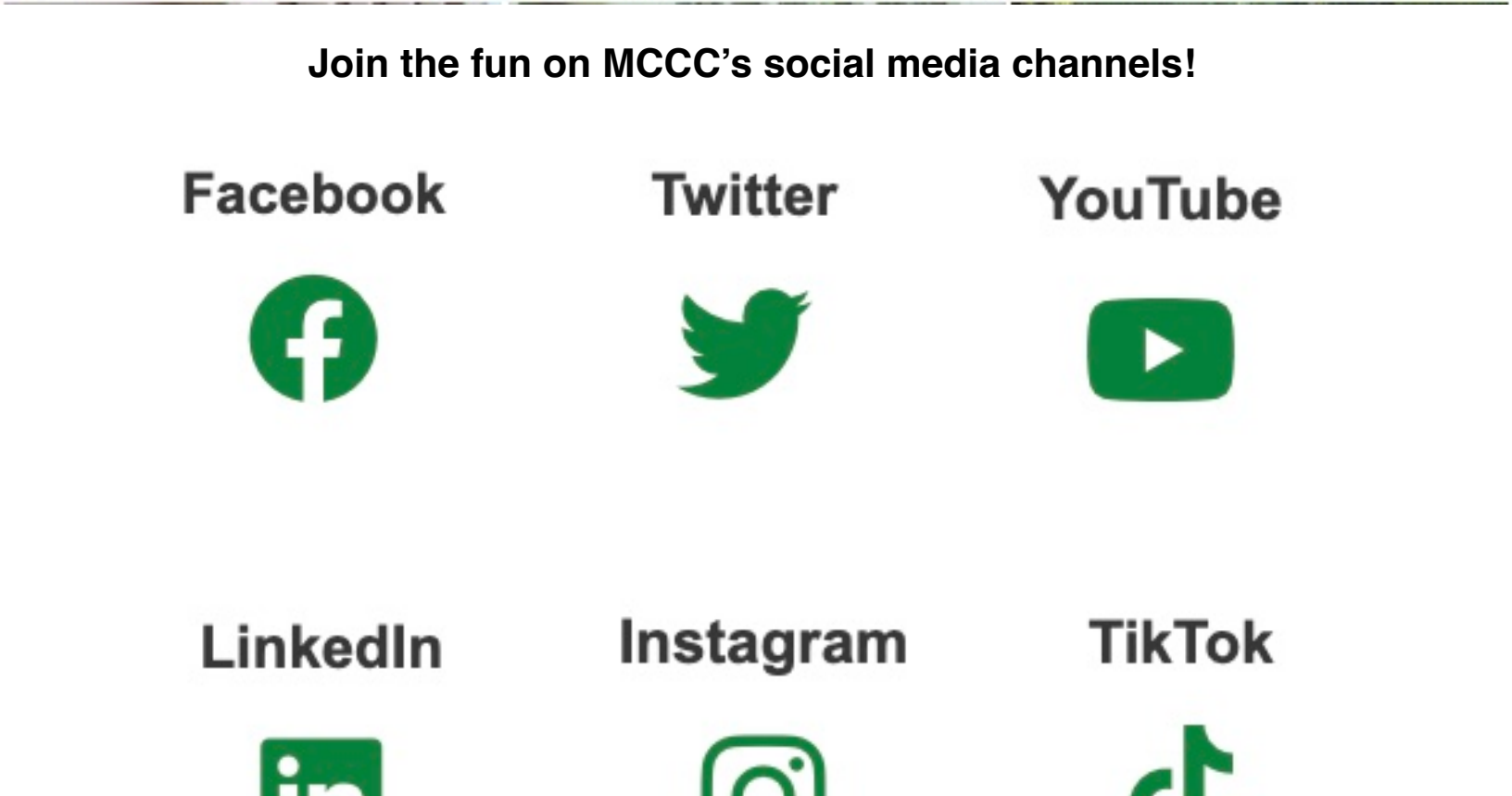

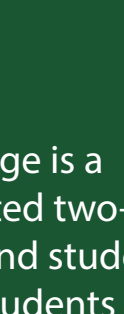
