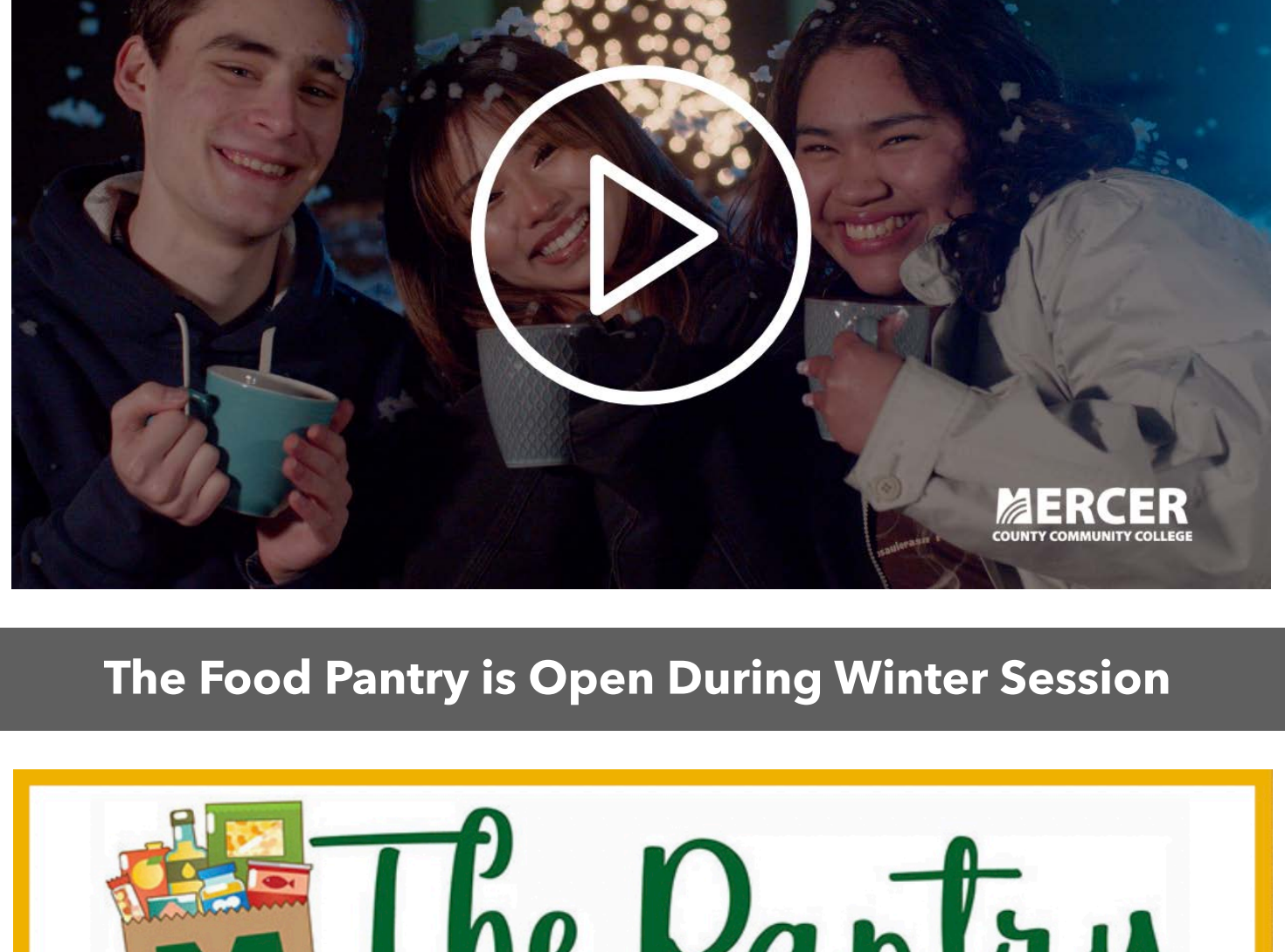

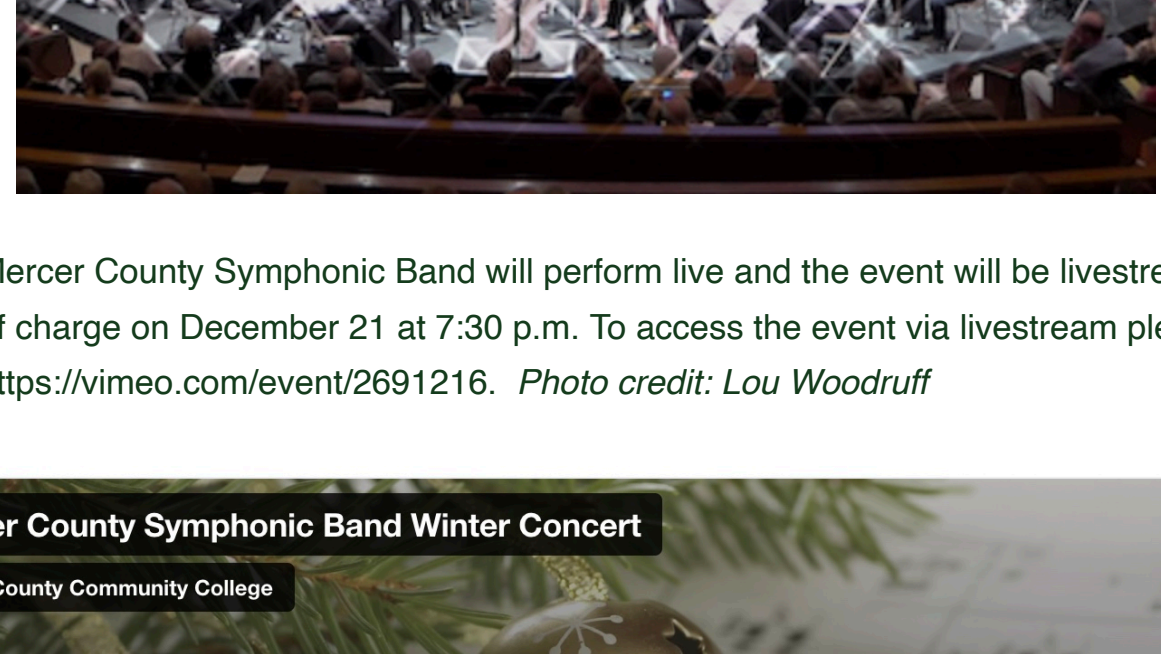

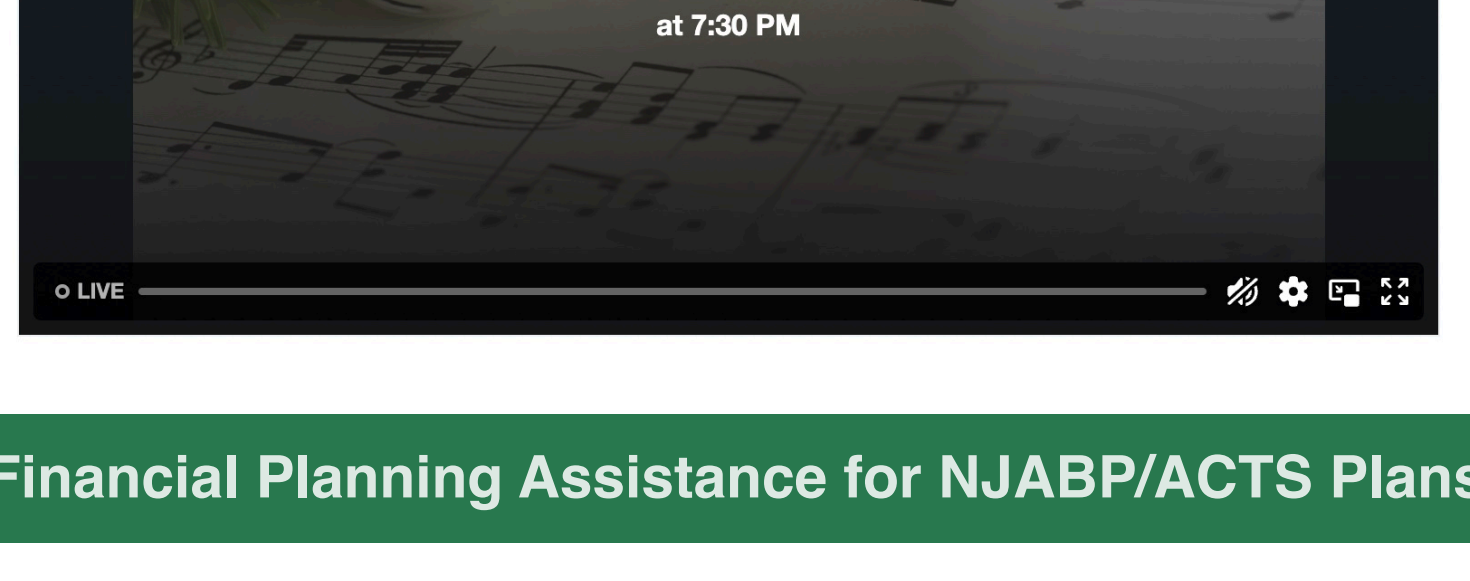

Financial Planning Assistance for NJABP/ACTS Plans

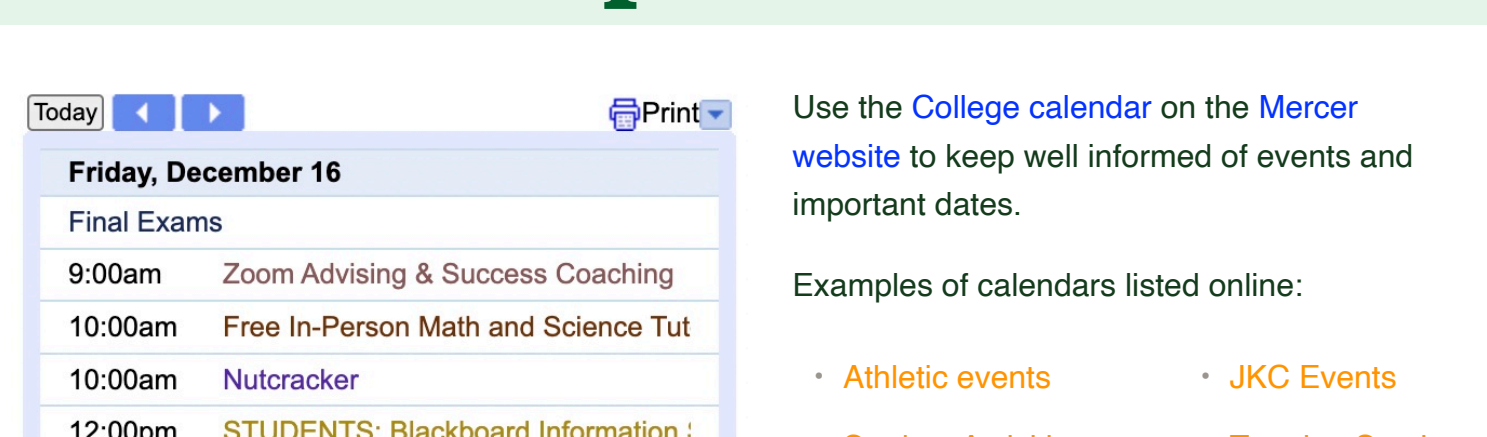
